The Department of Pharmacy Practice of the Auburn University Harrison School of Pharmacy (AUHSOP) is seeking at least *two (2)* full-time faculty positions at the Assistant/Associate/Full Professor or Assistant/Associate/Full Clinical Professor level. Positions are available in *Internal Medicine*. Each position carries responsibility for the provision of pharmaceutical care; providing clinical instruction for Pharm.D. students in the early and advanced experiential programs; developing and participating in student-centered pharmacotherapy learning; engaging in the scholarship of teaching, application, integration or discovery, and participating in University and School committee service. These positions will provide individuals with unique opportunities to deliver pharmaceutical care services in both primary and acute care settings. Pharmacy Practice faculty are located in the Mobile, Huntsville, Tuscaloosa, Montgomery, and Auburn, Alabama areas as well as Columbus, Georgia.

Depending upon experience, qualifications, and interest, successful candidates may be appointed to either a tenure-track (Assistant/Associate/Full Professor) or a non-tenure clinical track (Assistant/Associate/Full Clinical Professor) position. Applicants must possess a Pharm.D. degree with a postgraduate residency and be eligible for pharmacy licensure in the state in which they practice. Additional consideration will be given to candidates who have completed a fellowship or specialty residency and board certification. Salary will be competitive and commensurate with education and practice experience. The candidate selected for this position must be able to meet eligibility requirements to work in the United States at the time the appointment is scheduled to begin and continue working legally for the proposed term of employment.

Auburn University is one of the nation's premier land, sea, and space grant institutions. In the 2012 edition of the U.S. News and World Report ratings of undergraduate programs, it was ranked 36th among public universities.
